

General Info and Enrolment Details

- Full payment required prior to commencement unless alternative arrangements have been approved by the Coordinator. In cases of financial hardship please contact the office to arrange a payment plan. Conc rates only to healthcare card holders.
- Payment must be made in full on enrolment or before attending the 1st class or c/care. A Casual fee when attending less than the full term will be charged at a pro rata rate plus \$8 p/session (min of 5 weeks to be paid). To be paid at the beginning of the term.
 - Requirement lists provided upon enrolment. Most class materials costs are not incl in the fees. Manuals additional.
 - Classes & childcare are not scheduled on public & school holidays. Tutors will arrange extra sessions during term for make-up if class is cancelled by the House. <u>Refund Policy</u>: Fees will be refunded less a \$10 admin fee if

cancellation is received at least 5 days prior to course commencement, subject to the place being filled by another

- Student: No refund on any workshops. Pro rata refunds may be negotiable but not beyond half of the course's length.
- Concession Policy: Concessions of \$10 may be offered for some courses where the cost to attend the class is over \$80, to holders of a Health Care Card.
- Courses will run subject enrolment. Enrolment fees are not refundable. Refunds or credits are given if only courses are cancelled by the House. viability & commencement of classes dependent are on prepayment & commencement of participants no refunds are provided after/during the term.
- Privacy: RFSCH respects all personal & confidential info you give in the process of enrolment. Personal info (and/or health info) will only be used for the purpose for which it is collected & safeguarded from misuse. Further info re privacy available in our Participant Info brochure or enquire at the office.
- A full day fee will be charged if participants with disabilities are attending our centre for the whole day.
- For any course, NDIS participants will be charged according to NDIS price list cost. Prices are

subject to change according to NDIS price.
